  - b) Relevant qualifications
  - c) Details of information security related consulting delivered in the last two years, together with your typical client daily rate – you may omit client names to comply with any NDAs.
2. Details of any existing relationships with other organisations that are similar to the ECSC Associate Consultant Programme.
3. Letter of application.
